- Check your child's folder/work each night and contact your child's teacher with any questions or concerns that you may have
- Always send your child to school with words of praise and encouragement. Praising your child can be a powerful motivator that will have a positive impact on student achievement.

## Third Grade News

Time is flying and we have been busy in 3rd grade! Math has been full of place value activities, addition and subtraction word problems, and we have now jumped into multiplication strategies. In reading we have learned about plot, setting, and author's purpose of fiction texts, and some classes have enjoyed *The Boxcar Children* and *Because of Winn Dixie*. Science has been full of investigations and experiments that have allowed us to explore magnetism, the water cycle, temperature, and the three states of matter. We wrap up our days with Social Studies and have been learning about our communities and the workers that play a role in our day to day living. We are off to a great start, and look forward to the exciting learning to come!

## Fourth Grade News

The fourth grade has been learning and becoming better leaders. In reading, we have been studying poetry and fictional stories. We are finishing up the book, Love That Dog, by Shannon Creech and have begun studying dramas. We have already begun our reading competition for the year. Make sure you are reading your chapter books to reach 50 AR points by the end of April. In math, we are working on our multiplication facts and striving to show mastery in all skills. Science has been exciting because we are doing lots of experiments. All in all, we have grown to be better students and leaders with our 7 Habits!

## Fifth Grade News

Fifth grade students have been reviewing and demonstrating the “Leader in Me” traits this first six weeks. We will “Begin with the End in Mind” by setting both academic and behavior goals in our classroom and leadership notebooks and track and record our performance.

In Math, students are taking notes in their personal math journals which have helped them reflect and summarize what they have learned during the first six weeks. Students use their notes to summarize, share, and reflect what they have learned both with their classmates and their parent/guardian.

Students are used hands-on investigations in 5th grade Science to complete units on Science Safety and Physical Properties of Matter. Our next unit will focus on Forces. The students will design an investigation that will test the effects of force on an object while collecting data. Units covering the topics of Light and Electrical Energy and Energy Resources are to follow.

Great news in reading! Everyone passed the Unit 1 Reading test on fiction. Two students have already passed their 50 point yearly AR goal and more are close behind. Please encourage your child to read each day in order to reach this reading goal. We will be focusing on literary non-fiction and drama during the second grading period. Be on the lookout for the requirements of an independent project that will be due at the end of the six weeks.

In Social Studies, the students are using USA Studies Weekly and connected web sites to explore colonization of the new world. They are reading fiction and poetry in English Language Arts and are being encouraged to increase their independent reading skills by participating in Accelerated Reading. Also, the students recently completed their first book report project in Reading. They were asked to design a postcard using the elements of a short story.
