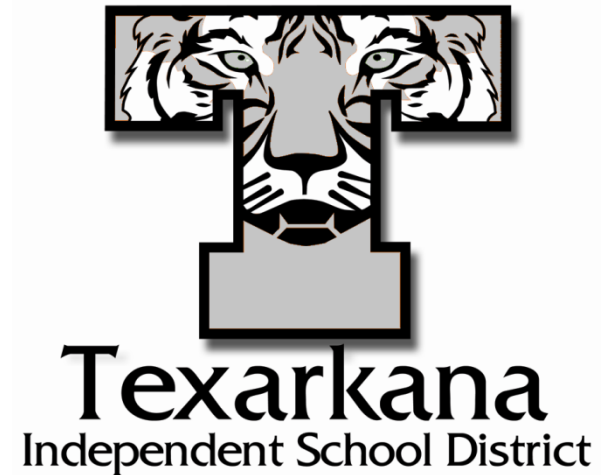

TEXAS MIDDLE SCHOOL PERFORMANCE OBJECTIVES 2015-2016

- Goal 1:** We will commit to providing a relevant, challenging curriculum that rapidly responds to the diverse needs of the students, community and global workforce.
- Objective 1: 80% of all students and student groups will meet the passing standard on all state assessments.
- Objective 2: Texas Middle School will increase the completion rate to 100% in all student groups.
- Objective 3: Texas Middle School will lower the achievement gap among student groups in all core classes.
- Objective 4: As measured by System Safeguards, Texas Middle School will increase all core areas to at least 60% or 5% (Whichever is Higher). This will make Reading 81%, Math 79%, Writing 78%, Social Studies 59%, Science 68%. There will be an intense focus on Social Studies for all subgroups. There will an intense focus on Science for AA, ED, and SPED. SPED will be targeted for all subject areas.
- Objective 5: Develop and implement a targeted plan to focus on writing across the curriculum.
- Objective 6: Decrease the number of special education students receiving modified curriculum and instruction and the number of regular education students considered at-risk of failure through continued implementation of Response to Intervention (RTI) strategies in reading and mathematics.
- Objective 7: Increase performance in all student groups through delivery of a rigorous and relevant instructional program using the district curriculum.
- Objective 8: Texas Middle School will provide students with opportunities to extend learning beyond the classroom by participating in one career connections project in each core academic subject (English language arts, mathematics, science, and social studies).
- Objective 9: All Texas Middle School students will engage in project-based learning activities designed to promote higher level critical thinking skills based on real-world activities.
- Objective 10: Increase student performance on measurement objectives in math and science by focusing on targeted objectives.

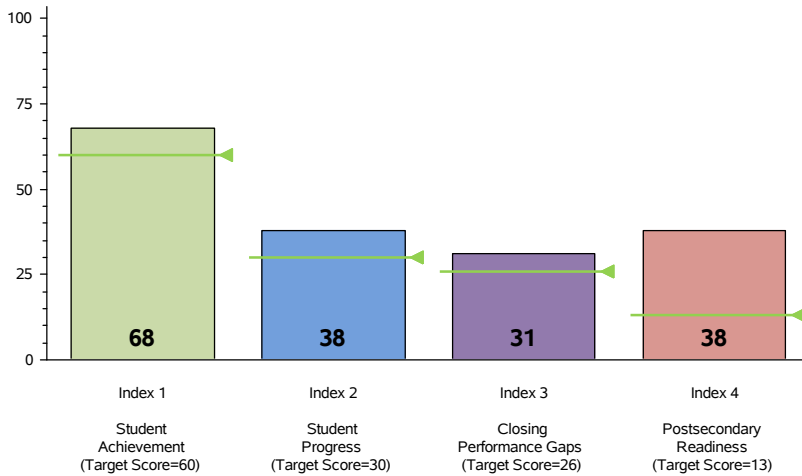
