Dr. Martin Luther King was born in Atlanta, Georgia on January 15, 1929. He gave his life in efforts to serve humanity. He exhibited a nonviolent approach to striving for civil rights for all people. Dr. King is remembered for his many positive contributions to society: Nobel Peace Prize winner, Church pastor, author, civil rights leader, among others. Dr. King was married to the late Coretta Scott King with whom he was the parent of four children.
