**TEXAS HIGH SCHOOL'S DREW DANIELS
SELECTED AS OUTSTANDING PERFORMER
DURING 2010 TEXAS STATE SOLO & ENSEMBLE PERCUSSION SOLO CONTEST**

Texarkana, TX – The University Interscholastic League (UIL) has selected Drew Daniels, Texas High School Band student, as an Outstanding Performer for the 2010 Texas State Solo & Ensemble Percussion Solo Contest.



From an original field of 85,000 students who participated in the Regional UIL contests, to the 22,000 student musicians who participated in the State competition, Daniels is only one of 231 students to earn the distinguished honor of being recognized as an Outstanding Performer. This distinction is given to few and is representative of excellence in music. He is the first Texas High School band student to earn the recognition.

Daniels, a Sophomore at Texas High School, played a Mallet Percussion Solo on the Marimba during the competition. He is the son of Nancy and James Daniels.
