**FORMER TIGERVISION STUDENTS EARN NATIONAL ACCLAIM
DURING STUDENT TELEVISION NETWORK FALL NATIONALS**

Texarkana, TX – Two former Texas High School TigerVision students earned national acclaim in the Music Video category during the Student Television Network (STN) Fall Nationals.

THS 2011 graduates, Cody Lee and Nick Burt, took the Second Place title for their music video, “Seasons Change.” The category required that students submit an original music video based on any original or rights-cleared music. Judges looked for camera/direction, lighting, audio/music, talent, editing, graphics/effects, storytelling/content, creativity, courage/impact

According to Charles Aldridge, TigerVision/Media Technology teacher, “Cody wrote an amazing original song. Then, he and Nick planned out the video storyline for the song, took about a week to shoot and then followed with a few weeks of editing.” The final submission was completed during the end of their senior year and was submitted for the Fall 2011 awards.

The video storyline shows a young student caught up in the social party scene and peer pressures of high school. Through self-discovery, he comes to the realization that life is not all about what others want you to be but remaining true to yourself.

The STN Fall Nationals are presented in recognition of excellence in scholastic broadcast television and honor the special skills and unique talents of broadcasting and film students from across the nation. Only STN affiliates may be submit entries.
